Comment on Gemini 3's assessment of "Prufrock Unobscured." The parable of "The Blind Men and the Elephant" appears to be wholly overlooked. A profoundly humorless read. I not only dismissed past criticism on Prufrock with its tolerance of incoherence but I wanted to forget it altogether. The poem is replete with metaphors as camouflage but taken together with the Aristotelian read it is shaped as a very, very good (100 year old) joke. Why the Gemini borderline pathological frown? Why must I venerate past criticism which I view as the poem's critical landfill? The parable's point I thought was to show how much nonsense goes on out there and to help shrug it off. The distance between my read and the landfill is immaterial if the poem's living structure has nothing to do with it. Gemini still lives in a prison.
