This literalist anchoring provides a fixed point of reference around which the rest of the narrative is built.
- **Sequential Mapping:** The interpretation's strongest evidence for structure comes from its ability to map the poem's lines onto a strict chronological sequence. The "yellow fog" stanza is the prime exhibit, re-framed not as a wandering image but as a direct, step-by-step description of a "flush cycle." This sequential reading—from evacuation to the water draining through outdoor plumbing—is the core proof of a hidden but rigid narrative structure.
- **Anatomical Literalism:** The reading of "back" and "muzzle" as literal body parts in need of cleaning is a powerful example of the method. It systematically rejects the figurative (a cat-like fog) in favor of the "improperly visual" and physical. This commitment to literalism is the primary tool used to reveal the underlying structure.
- **Rejection of Ambiguity:** The structure's integrity is reinforced by its explicit dismissal of other readings as "mangled by critics and obtuse software."
